2020-EO-06: Further Guidance for Closing Achievement Gaps and Creating Safe Spaces for Learning

I. Review of Reopening Requirements

- a. All schools open – Assurance 1
- b. Full panoply of services – Assurance 2
- c. Progress monitoring – Assurance 3
- d. Students with Disabilities and English Language Learners – Assurances 4 & 5
- e. Equitable school flexibility (traditional public, public charter and private)

Reopening Plan Details

- District Reopening Plans are due to the Department by July 31, 2020
- Assurance Form and optional Reopening Plan template will be provided by the Department to districts by July 9, 2020

Charter Schools should provide their Reopening Plan to their host district in a timeline as directed by their district.

Secure FTE Funding

A district must agree to Assurances, submit a Reopening Plan and receive approval from the Department to secure funding for the Fall.

II. Reopening Plans

- a. **School districts** must submit a reopening plan that satisfies the requirements of this Order to the Department.
- b. **Charter school governing boards** must submit a reopening plan to the sponsoring district.
- c. **Private schools that accept scholarship students** must submit a reopening plan to the Department.

Plan format and the review and approval process will be established by the Department.
