EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to modify Rule 6A-10.024, F.A.C., so that it aligns with the changes outlined in House Bill 1285 (2024). The amended rule language will incorporate the addition of SAAT degree programs and will update the Credit by Examination List for the 2024-25 academic year. Language related to credit for certain prior experience in the military or law enforcement is being removed and outlined in new Rule 6A-10.0244, F.A.C. The new rule will outline the procedures and requirements a Florida postsecondary institution must follow to award credit to potential students based on their previous occupation and the training and experience associated with that occupation.
