## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose of the amendments is to incorporate legislative changes from House Bill 1425 (2024) and Senate Bill 7004 (2024), which amend Sections 1003.01, 1003.51 and 1003.52, Florida Statutes, and add and remove district and Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) requirements within the rule for the provision of educational services, assessments, instructional hours and education program accountability for students in juvenile justice schools. The rule specifically changes the responsibility for the provision of educational services to students in DJJ residential commitment programs from school districts to the newly established DJJ Florida Scholars Academy.
