The Department of Education plans to initiate rule development for Rule 6A-10.024, Florida Administrative Code, Articulation Between and Among Universities, Florida Colleges, and School Districts. The purpose of this rule amendment is to update Rule 6A-10.024 to incorporate a Statewide Credit for Military Experience Equivalency List that provides for the uniform awarding of military credit.
