On January 14, 2015, the State Board of Education established Achievement Levels for the Civics End-of-Course (EOC) Assessment. Summer 2014 Civics EOC Assessment scores were reported to students as T scores. The Summer 2014 results have been converted to the new score scale and are being provided based on the established Achievement Levels so that stakeholders and the general public are able to see what they would have been if the new score scale and Achievement Levels had been approved and implemented at that time.
