STUDENT ASSESSMENT –REJECT RULES

 34. If Test Name is IBP then Test Score (1) must be 0001, 0002, 0003, 0004, 0005, 0006, 0007, 0008, ~~or~~ 0009, 0010, 0011, 0012, 0013 or 0014. -record rejected-

EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Test Score is not valid for the Test Name reported.

Florida Education Identifier	Test Date	Test Name	Test Score
FL123456789100	06012009	IBP	0007
* FL123456789100	06012009	IBP	B

DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the Test Score and resubmit the record.

5A. If Survey Period Code is 2, 3 or 5 and If English Language Learners, PK-12 is LY or LF and if there is a matching English Language Learners Information record and if there is a matching Student Course Schedule or Student End of Year Status record, then the English Language Learners: Classification Date must not equal zero.

The match between the Student Demographic Information record and the English Language Learners Information record should be based on District Number, Current Instruction/~~Service;~~Service; Florida Education Identifier; Survey Period Code and Fiscal/School Year.

The match between the Student Demographic Information record and the Student Course Schedule record should be based on District Number, Current Instruction; District Number, Current Enrollment; Florida Education Identifier; Survey Period Code; Year/Fiscal Year and District Instruction is equal to District of Enrollment.~~District Number, Current Enrollment; Florida Education Identifier; Survey Period Code; and Fiscal Year.~~

The match between the Student Demographic Information and the Student End of Year Status record should be made based on District Number, Current ~~Enrollment;~~Enrollment; Florida Education Identifier; Survey Period Code; and Year/School Year.

If Survey Period Code is 2, 3 or 5 and if English Language Learners, PK-12 is LY or LF and if there is a matching English Language Learners Information record and if there is a matching Student Course Schedule or Student End of Year Status record, then the English Language Learners: Basis of Entry code on the English Language Learners Information record must not = Z.

The match between the Student Demographic Information record and the English Language Learners Information record should be based on District Number, Current Instruction/~~Service~~; Service; Florida Education Identifier; Survey Period Code and Fiscal/School Year.

The match between the Student Demographic Information record and the Student Course Schedule record should be based on District Number, Current Instruction; District Number, Current ~~Enrollment~~; Enrollment; Florida Education Identifier; Survey Period Code; ~~and~~ Year/Fiscal Year and District Instruction is equal to District of Enrollment.

The match between Student Demographic Information and Student End of Year Status record should be made based on District Number, Current ~~Enrollment~~; Enrollment; Florida Education Identifier; Survey Period Code; and Year/School Year.
