Tip of the Week

Know What Constitutes 'Suspicion of Disability' for Child Find

Clarify with your team what information rises to the level of "reason to suspect a disability" triggering the district's child find obligation. A reported diagnosis, concerns, symptoms or behaviors must impact a child's education in a way that special education services may be needed to address a disability. (Special Ed Connection®)
