



Rule 6A-10.0246, Florida Administrative Code, District Postsecondary Career and Technical Education Enrollment Requirements

Rule Development Workshop

Section 1 – Purpose

- The purpose of this rule is to specify admission requirements for postsecondary programs.

Section 2 – Applicability

- This rule applies to students being admitted to the following programs.
 - Site-determined associate in applied science and associated in science degree programs
 - Career Certification
 - Technology Diplomas
 - Apprenticeship Programs
 - Dual Enrollment

Section 3 – Admission Requirements

- Lawfully present United States citizen;
- Satisfy programmatic admission requirements;
- Reasonable accommodations for religion;
- Reasonable accommodation for disabilities; and
- Non-discriminatory against race, color, national origin, sex, disability, religion or marital status.

Section 4 – Admission Policies

- All requirements including this new rule must apply to all students and be posted on the website of each school district operating a career center or a charter technical career center.

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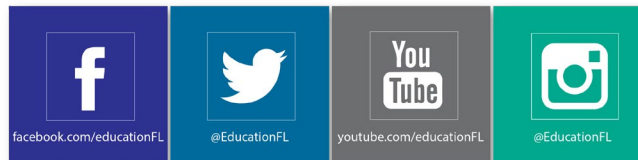
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
