Best Practices for Inclusive Education (BPIE) Assessment for Students with Disabilities (SWDs) Reminder

The BPIE assessment is an internal process designed to facilitate the analysis, implementation and improvement practices for SWDs who are served in regular classes. Section 1003.57, Florida Statutes, requires that once every three years, each school district and school complete a

BPIE assessment. Florida Inclusion Network (FIN) facilitators are required to assist school districts in this process. The results of this process must be included in each school district's exceptional student education policies and procedures. School BPIE assessments should be completed prior to the end of the school year. Notify Families of Staff Vacancies

Notify families impacted by special education service gaps within three weeks of a vacancy. Update them on the hiring of a new provider and a make-up plan for missed services. Since staffing shortages are no excuse for failing to implement individual educational plans, be prepared to authorize parents to obtain independent services until the vacancy is filled.
