Florida Standards Assessments Portal

- Portal launched on June 30, 2014 to provide parents, students, schools and districts with information on the new assessment
- Over 550,000 unique visitors to the portal
- Over 2.6 million page views



Florida Standards Assessments Portal Resources

- Summer 2014
 - Training tests and sample calculators for student practice
 - Test specifications and blueprints that provide information on which standards are assessed, numbers of questions on each test, and types of questions on each test.
 - Rubrics for how the English language arts text-based writing component will be scored
 - Resources to help districts and schools prepare (e.g., testing calendar, computer-based transition schedule, technical requirements)



Florida Standards Assessments Portal Resources

- Fall 2014
 - Updates to policies, rubrics, blueprints and specifications to provide additional detail on the assessments, including testing time
 - Test administration user guides for districts and schools
 - Sample mathematics reference sheets
 - Writing planning sheets
 - Writing response sheets for paper-based writing in grades 4-7.



Florida Standards Assessments Resources

- Coming Winter 2014-15
 - Paper-based practice materials for regular print paper in Grades
 3 & 4 and paper-based accommodations for Grades 5-11 and
 EOCs
 - Large print and braille practice material
 - Seven regional face-to-face trainings for district and school test administrators from January 26-February 5
 - In addition, the Office of Assessment and AIR's Help Desk have been and will continue to answer emails and calls from students, teachers, and the public regarding the new assessments.



Completed Assessments

- **Fall NGSSS**: Algebra 1 Retake, Biology 1, Civics, Geometry Retake, U.S. History, FCAT Mathematics Retake, FCAT 2.0 Reading Retake
 - Last use of Pearson TestNav 6.9 platform
- Winter NGSSS EOCs: Algebra 1 Retake, Biology 1, Civics, Geometry Retake, U.S. History
 - First use of Pearson TestNav 8 platform, which provides for use of tablets.



Upcoming FSA Milestones

- February 13: Complete field testing for the FSA ELA Writing Component
 - Testing began December 1st on computer in Grades 8-11 (AIR's TDS platform)
 - Over 5,000 tests complete thus far across 16 districts. No issues reported.
 - Paper-based writing field test in Grades 4-7 begins 2/2.
- March 2-13 2015: FSA ELA Writing Component operational assessment
- March 23-April 10: FSA Grades 3 & 4 ELA and mathematics
- April 13-May 8: FSA Grades 5-11 ELA and Grades 3-8 mathematics
- April 20-May 15: FSA EOCs (Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2)
- No later than the week of June 8: Report results (percentile rank and t scores for all grades, plus linked scores for Grades 3 & 10 ELA and Algebra 1)
