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College Affordability Senate Bill 938 Sponsored by Senator Flores

Textbook Sales Tax Exemption

• Exempts required textbooks, for courses offered by public and certain nonpublic postsecondary institutions, from sales tax

College Affordability

- Allows workforce education programs, universities and state colleges to charge any amount below the standard tuition rates
- Requires governing boards for state universities and state colleges to research options to reduce the cost of higher education

College Transparency

 Requires state colleges and universities to publicly notice any potential tuition or fee increases 30 days prior to the board of trustees meeting

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College Affordability

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Hold the line on Graduate Tuition

Prohibit state universities from increasing tuition for graduate and professional programs

Textbook Affordability

- Requires the cost of recommended and required textbooks and instructional materials in the course registration system 14 days prior to student registration
- Requires the use of textbooks for a minimum of three years
- Requires consultation with school districts on dual enrollment textbooks
- Requires a regular cost benefit analysis in comparing textbook and instructional materials options to ensure lowest price available
- Requires annual report from Board of Governors and State Board on textbook initiatives

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Assessment

Commissioner's Assessment Investigation Recommendations:

- Elimination of Grade 11 ELA assessment
- Elimination of the PERT requirement for 11th grade and make it optional
- Eliminate progress monitoring requirements
- Eliminate local final exams where there is also a statewide standardized end-of-course exam



Personal Learning Scholarship Account (PLSA) Senate Bill 602 Sponsored by Senator Gaetz

- Expands the definition of autism to be eligible for the PLSA program to be consistent with the American Psychiatric Associations Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, fifth edition
- Governor Scott's recommended budget provided for an additional \$5 million for a total of \$23.4 million to provide this opportunity for additional students





Charter Schools

- Allow for immediate termination of double "F" charters unless a waiver is granted
- Defines financial emergency for charters that receive capital outlay funding
- Requires the consideration of past performance by an applicant or applicant group
- Clarifies that districts must provide monthly funding based on 1/12 projected state an local funding
- Allows charter schools to receive a proportionate share of the reading allocation with an approved reading plan
- Governor Scott's Budget Recommendations provided for \$100 million for charter school FCO

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Educator Professional Practices SB 888 Sponsored by Sen. Detert/ House Bill 587 Sponsored by Rep. Spano

- Authority for Letter of Caution
- Access to DCF child protective investigations
- Reorganize Education Practices Commission (EPC) membership
- Allow for emeritus members to continue to serve





Career Education and Job Training Senate Bill 948 sponsored by Senator Gaetz

- Technical revisions to align apprenticeship program with federal definitions
- Provides rulemaking authority to define quality components of a career and technical education program
- Clarifies additional FTE funding for career and professional academies (CAPE) as well as career themed courses
- Governor Scott's budget recommendation provided for \$20 million new funds for the Technical Center Rapid Response Grants for programs linked to workforce demands



Repealer/Clean up/Technical Legislation

- Removes duplicative and outdated statutes and statutory references
- Provides clarifying language including:
 - Defines double session schools
 - Revises current transportation funding methodology
 - Clarifies funding for DJJ students
 - Clarifies employment and loan status for the Nursing Loan Forgiveness Program
 - Removes VR as a resource for interpreter services for deaf persons
