

Additional Information for Turnaround Option Plan 2016: Hudson Elementary

Leadership:

The 2016-17 school year will be the first school year at Hudson Elementary for the selected principal. This principal has demonstrated successful experience as a principal and led her previous school to a C grade.

The 2016-17 school year will also be the first school year at Hudson Elementary for the selected assistant principal. This assistant principal has also demonstrated success as an assistant principal and was part of an administrative team that led another school to a C grade.

External Operator:

Pasco County Schools has entered into a contract with The New Teacher Project (TNTP) to engage in turnaround work explicitly at Hudson Elementary.

TNTP has an established record of partnering with districts to raise student achievement in high-need and turnaround schools. TNTP has worked closely with districts in Charlotte, NC, Springfield, MA, and Pinellas, FL.

In Pinellas County, Florida, TNTP worked intensively with 5 elementary schools, providing ongoing coaching and professional development on the shifts of the standards. Three of the 5 increased their school grade at least one letter grade from 2015 to 2016. The two schools remaining an F demonstrated improvement based upon percent of points earned.
