EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A letter of Intent followed by a proposal was submitted to the Department of Education for both proposals. Appropriate notification of intent was provided to the Board of Governors, Independent Colleges and Universities of Florida and the Commission for Independent Education, as required in section 1007.33, Florida Statutes. An extensive review of criteria was conducted for the proposals submitted, and written comments and recommendations were provided to the college. The final submissions were subsequently received and are being submitted to the State Board of Education for approval.

Summary

In this set of presentations, you will hear proposals for two new baccalaureate degree programs, which are opportunities to provide citizens of Florida greater access to higher education.

Miami Dade College, BS in Data Analytics

- Prior approved degrees range from Education, Nursing, Biological Science and Public Safety.
- Program offers an interdisciplinary approach which combines content from three academic areas: Computer Science, Mathematics and Business.
- Students graduating from the BS in Data Analytics will be prepared to work in a wide variety of industries such as banking and financial services, market research and pharmaceuticals.
- Data Analytics is an emerging field with significant job openings projected in the next five years.
- Local postsecondary institutions expressed support for the BS in Data Analytics program.

North Florida Community College, BS in Nursing

- This is the first baccalaureate proposal submitted by North Florida Community College.
- Currently, there is no Bachelors of Science in Nursing program available in the North Florida Community College service region.
- Data indicated a significant need for nurses with advanced training in the surrounding community.
- Local health care organizations expressed strong support for the program.
