SUBJECT: Approval of District Turnaround Option Plans for Schools Implementing Year 1 Turnaround in 2016-17

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Florida's school improvement system, also known as Differentiated Accountability (DA), requires non-charter schools that earn a D or F grade to complete a process for improved student performance. Any school earning a D or F grade immediately enters the DA system and is provided assistance of escalating intensity by the DA staff.

There are 69 schools in 24 districts requiring implementation of turnaround option plans (TOPs) for the first time in the 2016-17 school year; TOPs for 40 of these schools were approved at the September 23, 2016 meeting. This action item includes the TOPs for the remaining 29 schools in 10 districts. These schools earned D or F grades for three consecutive years beginning in 2013. Given the hold harmless provisions of Section 1008.34(7)(a), Florida Statutes, schools identified as "Planning" for the 2014-15 school year that did not improve to a "C" or higher, continued in the "Planning" status through 2015-16, which lengthened the process an additional year.

Upon approval, the district will implement the TOP for two school years, unless the school improves to a C grade or better in 2017. At the end of the two-year implementation period, those districts whose schools have not improved to a C grade or better, will present a new turnaround option plan to the state board for approval.
