## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This amendment will update the Florida School Bus Safety Inspection Manual to the 2017 edition, revise the schedule for recertification of Florida School Bus Safety Inspectors from a calendar year to a fiscal year basis, and incorporate the Florida School Bus Safety Inspection Form (2017-IF), State of Florida School Bus Safety Inspector Application (Form 2017-SI), and District Online Test Administrator Application (Form 2017-TA) by reference. The proposed rule will also include the requirement that school districts report bus inventories using the Online Bus Inventory Application (Form 420). This requirement was formerly in rule 6A-3.016, F.A.C., which is being repealed.

#### 6A-3.0171 Responsibilities of School Districts for Student Transportation.

Each school district shall exercise specific powers and responsibilities, as follows:

- (1) through (7) No change.
- (8) Inspection and maintenance of school buses.

(a) To provide, after considering recommendations of the superintendent, adequate storage, maintenance and inspection procedures for all buses owned by the school board, and to assure that all contract buses in use in the district are properly inspected and maintained in accordance with law and rules of the State Board of Education.

(b) The inspection shall be conducted in accordance with procedures and include all items listed in the State of Florida School Bus Safety Inspection Manual, <u>2017</u> <del>2008</del> Edition (DOS link) <u>and documented on the Florida School</u> <u>Bus Safety Inspection Form (2017-IF) effective March 2017.</u> The manual and form <u>2017-IF are which is hereby</u> incorporated by reference and made a part of this rule. <u>These This documents</u> may be obtained <u>from the</u> <u>Department's website at: http://fldoe.org/core/fileparse.php/7585/urlt/0085485-</u> <u>floridaschoolbussafetyinspectionmanual-1.pdf and may also be obtained</u> from the School Transportation Management Section <del>Bureau of Career Development</del>, Department of Education, 325 West Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399, at a cost not to exceed actual production and distribution cost.

(c) Inspection of buses shall be scheduled and performed at a maximum interval of thirty (30) school days. Any bus that is removed from service or deadlined so as to disrupt the safety inspection schedule shall be inspected prior to being returned to service. All deficiencies discovered during the safety inspection shall be noted on the inspection form (2017-IF). Follow-up repairs of all safety related items shall be made before the bus is returned to service and shall be documented.

(d) School bus inspections shall be conducted by technicians certified as school bus <u>safety</u> inspectors in accordance with the State of Florida School Bus Safety Inspection Manual, <u>2017</u> <del>2008</del> Edition. <u>The State of Florida</u> <u>School Bus Safety Inspector Application (Form 2017-SI) (DOS link) effective March 2017, and the District Online</u> <u>Test Administrator Application (Form 2017-TA) (DOS link) effective March 2017 are hereby incorporated by</u> <u>reference and made part of this rule. inspections be performed by a certified <u>Florida Sschool Bbus Safety</u> <u>I</u> inspector may be waived for a period not to exceed six (6) months when an emergency condition exists, upon written notification to the Commissioner <u>of</u> <u>Education</u> by the district superintendent.

(e) No person shall knowingly render inoperative or reduce compliance of any school bus equipment required to meet Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards applicable at the time of manufacture.

(9) Transportation records, reports and accounting.

(a) through (f) No Change.

(g) To report bus inventories using the department's Online Bus Inventory Application (Form 420), which may be accessed at http://app4.fldoe.org/BusOnlineInventory/Login.aspx. The department's Online Bus Inventory Application, Form 420 (DOS link) is hereby incorporated by reference, effective March 2017. For viewing purposes only, hard copies of the reporting requirements in the Online Bus Inventory Application may be obtained by contacting the Director of the School Transportation Management Section, Department of Education, 325 West Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399.
