\$10,893,981 less than 15 years ago for 303,497 UFTE more students

Calculating for inflation over the last 15 years and workload increase it would be \$112,256,000 - almost double this school year's allocation.



SAFE SCHOOLS RECOMMENDATION

 Recommend an increase in Safe School Allocation for traditional public schools and charter schools to \$112,000,000



OUT-OF-SCHOOL SUSPENSION (OSS)

- Student discipline problems are second only to dissatisfaction with salary as to why teachers leave the profession.
- Student who have even one OSS are 10 times more likely to drop out of school.
- Florida has the highest OSS rate in the country.



OSS RECOMMENDATION


- Support legislation to require a public hearing by school boards every three years of the districts rules authorizing out-of-school suspension.




