1. Major Legislative Initiative: Computer Coding Instruction

Expands opportunities for middle and high school students to learn coding and computer science.

- O Background Screening Exemption for instructional and noninstructional personnel who also provide services to VR clients in the same districts.

3. Major Legislative Initiative: Public Records Exemption

 To protect the personal, identifiable information of the department's investigative staff and prosecuting attorneys whose duties are to investigate and prosecute educators for misconduct

4. Major Legislative Initiative: Bright Futures

Provide assistance to our brightest students through the Bright Futures Scholarship program which entices our brightest students to attend a Florida postsecondary institution and hopefully remain in the state and contribute to the growth of Florida's economy.

 Expands the Bright Futures Scholarship to allow the scholarship dollars to be used to pay tuition differential and technology fees for the Academic Scholars award.
