# **Goals of the Florida Education System**

Section 1008.31, Florida Statutes

- 1. Highest student achievement, as indicated by evidence of student learning gains at all levels.
- Seamless articulation and maximum access, as measured by evidence of progression, readiness, and access by targeted groups of students identified by the Commissioner of Education.
- 3. Skilled workforce and economic development, as measured by evidence of employment and earnings.
- 4. Quality efficient services, as measured by evidence of return on investment.




#### **Metric 1: Student Achievement on Florida Assessments**




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




#### Percent of high school graduates who enroll in postsecondary education

the next postsecondary level









Annual average initial wages earned by program completers from these sectors combined over time: Florida College System, District Postsecondary, Vocational Rehabilitation, and Blind Services










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
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
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# **National Benchmark Updates**

- Advanced Placement (2017):
  - 1<sup>st</sup> state in participation
  - 4<sup>th</sup> state in performance
- National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) Average Scale Score (2017):
  - Moved from 10<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> in Grade 4 Reading
  - Moved from 32<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> in Grade 8 Reading
  - Moved from 18<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> in Grade 4 Math
  - Moved from 42<sup>nd</sup> to 34<sup>th</sup> in Grade 8 Math
- Aspen Prize for Community College Excellence
  - Three finalists for 2019: Broward, Indian River, Miami Dade



# **Next Steps**

- 2018-19 Activity Highlights
  - Tiered Support for Districts based on 2017-18 data
  - Florida Reads Best
  - Intensive assistance to districts with turnaround schools
  - Focus on strategies to close the achievement gap in all professional development programs
  - Vocational Rehabilitation new service delivery models to increase achievement of African-American students with disabilities
  - Colleges developing reports on postsecondary transition and AA transfers to focus on needs of specific student populations; dissemination of best practices
  - Commissioner's Convening
