## External Operator Phalen Leadership Academies

- Indiana based non-profit organization founded in 2013
- Currently serves over 4,000 students in Indianapolis, IN; Fort Wayne, IN; Gary, IN; and Detroit, MI
- Over $90 \%$ of PLA scholars are eligible for free lunch
- Strong track of success whose model has transformed 5 F-rated schools into A-rated (all within 3 years of take-over)
- Phalen has already exited a year 1 External Operator school. The school had been in turnaround for 5 years.
