EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This rule applies to all private postsecondary educational institutions licensed by the Commission for Independent Education. It revises and simplifies the requirements for voluntary closure of an institution. It specifies the contents of an orderly closure plan and requires institutions to update student records and transfer the records electronically to the Commission following closure for safekeeping. Any rule approved by the Commission must be submitted to the State Board for approval before it can go into effect. The Commission for Independent Education approved the rule at its January 23, 2020 meeting.
