## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Postsecondary institutions apply to the Council for approval to participate in the State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement (SARA). Florida is a state member of the National Council – SARA, which allows institutions to provide distance education services to students in other states without requiring individual licensure in each individual state. The proposed changes include adding a definition for "investigation," rewording conditions requiring provisional approval in FL-SARA, adding a condition for provisional approval, and updating applications and references to forms. These changes are necessary to conform the rule to changes made by the National Council and are needed to continue participation in the agreement.
