Teacher Preparation Program Accountability Metrics:

- 1. Placement rate of program completers into instructional positions in Florida public schools.
- 2. Rate of retention for employed program completers in instructional positions in Florida public schools.
- 3. Performance of students in pre-K through grade 12 who are assigned to infield program completers on statewide assessments using the results of Florida's student learning growth formula.
- 4. Performance of students in pre-K through grade 12 who are assigned to infield program completers aggregated by student subgroup.
- 5. Results of program completers' annual teacher evaluations.
- 6. Production of program completers in statewide critical teacher shortage areas. (Bonus Metric)



Executive Summary – Overall Findings

- Highest overall program ratings:
 - Elementary Education/ESOL/Reading at Florida Atlantic University
 - Middle Grades Mathematics at Indian River State College
 - Mathematics at Nova Southeastern University
 - Reading at Saint Leo University
- Forty-one programs improved their summative scores between 2019 and 2020, while 22 programs' scores decreased.
- Opportunity for Further Consideration:
 - 82 of 318 programs (26 percent) have enough performance data for their programs to receive a 2020 ranking.



Measures Supporting Teacher Preparation

- Largest teacher salary increase in Florida history (House Bills 641 and 5001 in 2020)
- Increased time to complete requirements for Temporary Certificates (Section 1012.56, F.S.)
- Five rules amended in 2019-20 to expand access and pathways to enter the classroom
