EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This proposed amendment provides guidelines to districts for determining what constitutes a substantial deficiency in reading. Three criteria are established that, if satisfied individually or in combination, would lead to a student being identified as having a substantial deficiency in reading.

Districts use decision trees within the rule to indicate what interventions and instruction students will receive.

The proposed amendment incorporates a plan template that school districts must use to apply for the research-based reading instruction allocation. The rule has also been modified to require information about summer reading camps and strategies for the 300 lowest-performing elementary schools through the incorporated template.
