EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

In 2020, the Florida Legislature passed Senate Bill 434 which added certain clock hour dual enrollment courses as eligible in the college and career acceleration component in the school grading formula.

This rule establishes the criteria for clock hour dual enrollment courses to be eligible in the college and career acceleration component of school and district grades. The rule also establishes reporting procedures for course reporting to the department. Lastly, the rule adopts the list of eligible clock hour dual enrollment courses, incorporated by reference.

High schools will earn credit in the school grading formula for students taking clock hour dual enrollment courses, and more secondary students may be encouraged to enroll in clock hour dual enrollment courses. District technical centers and Florida College System institutions will have to submit a list of clock hour dual enrollment courses being offered annually and may see an increase in clock hour dual enrollment.
