EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

House Bill 1507 created the Open Door Grant Program, which is intended to increase the interest of current and future workers in short-term, high-demand career and technical education (CTE) credentialing and certificate programs.

The proposed new rule specifies the procedures for implementation of the Open Door Grant Program at school district postsecondary technical career centers under section 1001.44, F.S., Florida College System institutions under section 1000.21(3), F.S., and charter technical career centers under section 1002.34, F.S., and provides information regarding key definitions, allocation of funds, award procedures, and institutional responsibilities.
