EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

A course description directs district personnel by providing the essential content and course requirements for each course in grades K-12 contained in the "Course Code Directory and Instructional Personnel Assignments" adopted by Rule 6A-1.09441, F.A.C. Course requirements approved by the State Board of Education are contained in the publication "Florida Course Descriptions for Grades K-12/Adult, Basic Education." This rule will adopt 50 courses containing the B.E.S.T. Standards for English Language Arts to be effective for the 2022-2023 school year for districts, schools and educators. It will also adopt 10 ELA courses with civics and government standards for the 2023-2024 school year.
