EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Rule 6A-6.0531, F.A.C., outlines RAISE supports provided by State Regional Literacy Directors and outlines a tutoring program in which eligible high school students are trained to tutor students in kindergarten through grade 3 in schools identified on the RAISE list, instilling a love of reading and improving their literacy skills. RAISE was established in HB 7011 (2021), which created s. 1008.365, F.S., to provide instructional supports to school districts, school administrators and instructional personnel in implementing evidence-based reading instruction and interventions in order to improve student reading achievement.

In addition to supports provided by State Regional Literacy Directors, this rule will assist in closing the reading achievement gap for students in kindergarten through grade 3 in schools identified on the RAISE list. The rule will outline minimum training criteria and processes for verifying tutoring hours of high school students for the designation of a New Worlds Scholar, as well as other requirements relating to a RAISE tutoring program.
