



Requirement for all threat assessment team members to be involved in the process – start to finish




Mental health crisis intervention training required for law enforcement officers who serve as safe-school officers



Significant Investments in School Safety



Significant Investments in School Safety

The 2022-2023 state budget includes \$396 million for school safety and mental health initiatives:

- \$210 million Safe School Appropriation
- \$140 million Mental Health Assistance Allocation
- \$20 million School Hardening Grant
- \$6.5 million Coach Aaron Feis Guardian Grant
- \$6.4 million Alyssa's Alert/Panic Alarm
- \$5.5 million Youth Mental Health Awareness


