EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Senate Bill 1028, approved by the 2021 Legislature, authorizes state universities and Florida College System (FCS) institutions to solicit applications and sponsor charter schools, upon approval by the Florida Department of Education. This proposed new rule sets forth the procedures and standards for review and approval of an FCS institution or a State University System (SUS) institution to act as a sponsor of a charter school, pursuant to section 1002.33, F.S.
