EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this rule amendment is to expand the definition of children with developmental delays. Formerly, the definition in this rule was age 3 through age 5. The new definition is age 3 through age 9, or through completion of grade 2, whichever occurs first. The change is a result of the in the 2022 Legislative Session in Senate Bill 236, Chapter 2022-24, Laws of Florida.
