**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Charter schools have been required to develop procedures to resolve parental complaints for many years. The proposed rule requires charter schools to address concerns about student welfare as set forth in House Bill 1557, Parental Rights in Education, and these procedures must address student welfare concerns on an expedited basis to mirror school district obligations under House Bill 1557. The Model Florida Charter School Application, Model Florida Virtual Charter School Application, Florida Standard Charter Contract, and Florida Standard Charter Renewal Contract are amended to include parental resolution procedures.
