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
Support and Strategies for 2022-2023

- New Principal and Assistant Principal at each campus Teacher recruitment/retention bonuses
- Job fairs to recruit effective/ highly effective teachers Extended School Day to accommodate an additional 60 minutes of daily, targeted reading interventions Reading Staff Training Specialist assigned to coach teachers in literacy

- 2 Academic Interventionists to manage and facilitate math and/or reading interventions and data tracking After-school tutoring using FCRR material
- Additional paraprofessional classroom support to support small group math and reading instruction Teacher stipends for additional professional development in alignment with ELA and Math
