

Approval of Action Item #8 – Dual Enrollment Scholarship Program

Rule 6A-20.0282, Florida Administrative Code



Dual Enrollment Scholarship Program

- Dual enrollment allows high school students the opportunity to enroll in postsecondary courses and receive both high school and postsecondary credit.
- Florida's vast dual enrollment opportunities save high school students both time and money in pursuit of higher education.
- The Dual Enrollment Scholarship Program provides reimbursement to eligible postsecondary institutions for tuition and instructional materials for dual enrollment students.



Senate Bill 2524 - Education

- Clarified the terms (fall, spring, and summer) with regard to which student expenses qualify for a reimbursement.
- Revised reporting dates from exact dates specified in rule language to 30 days after the end of regular registration.
- Revised funding dates from exact dates specified in rule language to 30 days after the institution has reported reimbursement amounts.



Proposed Amended Rule

- Revises language regarding reporting secondary students enrolled in dual enrollment courses to correctly state that the Reimbursement Request Report will be used.
- Clarifies that funds will be distributed to postsecondary institutions within 30 days after receipt of the final institution Reimbursement Request Report.
