EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This amendment adopts standards and benchmarks for the K-12 state academic standards for health. New strands were developed to align with statutory and State Board requirements and current health education topics identified as high priority in schools.

This amendment adopts standards and benchmarks for the K-12 state academic standards for social studies to include a new K-12 strand for African American History (AAH). The AAH strand was developed to align with statutory and State Board requirements.

This amendment adopts new K-12 courses that will satisfy the new financial literacy graduation requirement in effect for students entering 9th grade in 2023-24.
