Priority to Protect Students

- Ensures the health, safety and welfare of students.
- Raises the bar for educator conduct.
- Informs educators of additional acts or conduct that are considered grossly immoral or an act of moral turpitude.



Proposed Rule Amendment

 An act or omission, regardless of whether the individual is charged with or convicted of any criminal offense, that would constitute a violation of Sections 794.011, 794.027, 794.05, 794.051, 800.02, 800.03, 800.04, 800.09, 800.101, 827.03, 827.04, 827.071, 827.10, or 827.11, F.S., is presumed to be a gross immorality, unless the certificate holder can prove by a preponderance of the evidence through mitigating factors that the act or omission was not one of gross immorality.
