Rule 6M-4.620, F.A.C., Health and Safety for School Readiness (SR) Providers

- Addresses health and safety and training requirements for providers contracted for the SR program.
- Establishes compliance with and enforcement of requirements to retain a SR contract.
- Applies to all programs contracted for SR, including licensed, registered, license-exempt, public and nonpublic schools and informal providers.



Rule 6M-4.620, F.A.C. – Proposed Revisions

- Clarifying health and safety requirements through removing outdated language, and aligning with, but not duplicating, Department of Children and Families' (DCF) health and safety requirements;
- Streamlining and consolidating regulation, replacing 8 forms with 2 forms; and
- Adding pediatric first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) components to required training to comply with Child Care and Development Funds (CCDF) subsidy program requirements.
