

Adoption of New Rule 6A-1.09550, F.A.C., Student Online Personal Information Protection

State Board of Education August 23, 2023



Purpose

- Protects personally identifiable information of students when using required online educational services.
- Sets forth requirements for policies that must be adopted by school districts and charter school governing boards to protect that information.
- Prompted by SB 662 from the 2023 Legislative Session.



Proposed Rule

- This rule will strengthen the rights of parents and safeguard their child's educational records against data mining and re-disclosure.
- Ensures that all contracts or agreements executed by school districts or charter schools protect the privacy of students from third-party vendors or a third-party service provider.
- Requires that only the necessary information is disclosed for the service being provided by the vendor and prohibits the disclosure or re-disclosure of that information, unless authorized.
