## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to align Rule 6A-14.0582 with changes made regarding intercollegiate student-athlete compensation and rights in House Bill 7-B (2023). These changes included removing restrictions on athlete earnings from their NIL, institutional involvement in NIL activities, and requirements/prohibitions for compensation and professional representation. The bill retained the mandate for financial literacy workshops for athletes, with enhancements that included entrepreneurship, revised timing, and increased rigor. The bill also provided liability protection to postsecondary institutions and their staff for routine decisions affecting athletes' NIL compensation. All of these changes are reflected in this revised rule.
