## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose and effect of the rule amendment is to implement changes from House Bill 7039 (2023), which requires the State Board of Education to establish course standards for dropout prevention and academic intervention programs. The amended rule also outlines minimum requirements for district procedures for credit recovery courses. Additional changes amend and remove outdated language, and clarify existing components.
