EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The 2023 Florida Legislature passed Senate Bill (SB) 240 that amended section 1003.4282, F.S., requiring the State Board of Education to establish a process that enables a student to receive work-based learning or credit in electives for completing a threshold level of demonstrable participation in extracurricular activities associated with career and technical student organizations.

The proposed rule establishes a process that enables a school district or charter school to award high school credit toward the award of a high school diploma.
