**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The amendment updates registration and enrollment reporting for adult education students. Proposed changes include the removal of references to Literacy Completion Points (LCPs), which have been discontinued in Florida as of the 2022-23 academic year, more detailed procedures on instructional hour reporting practices for agencies and auditors, and new language regarding Integrated Education and Training (IET) programs and Adult High School (AHS) programs and their related instructional hour reporting requirements. The proposed changes also change the title to be clearer on its purpose, clarifies definitions, introduces new definitions, and eliminates old definitions.
