EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Rule 6A-1.0019, F.A.C., sets forth requirements relating to threat management, a process by which school districts, K-12 schools, charter school governing boards, and charter schools identify, assess, manage, and monitor potential and real threats to student safety. The proposed amendment updates the threat management manual and instrument, and includes changes to certain deadlines, requirements for District Threat Management Coordinators, clarification of which administrator serves in the role of superintendent for entities that do not have one, and implementation of the new statewide threat management portal.
