**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

School districts must submit a TOP for State Board approval for any school earning two consecutive 'D' grades or a single 'F,' choosing from the four TOP types as outlined in Rule 6A-1.099811(7)(b), F.A.C.

At the January State Board of Education meeting, the TOP Reassignment and Closure request for Greenville Elementary School in Madison County was approved with the following conditions:

1. The district will provide a regular update on the consolidation process to the Commissioner and the State Board of Education.
2. The district will monitor former Greenville student performance for three years.
3. The district will provide regular updates to the Commissioner and the State Board of Education on repairs of Madison County Central School.
4. The district will provide a report to the Commissioner and the State Board of Education of additional resources that may be needed.

In addition, State Board of Education members requested an update at the beginning of the 2025-26 school year on the TOP conditions and transition of students from Greenville Elementary School to Madison County Central School.

During the 2024-25 school year, Greenville Elementary earned a school grade of 'D' following three consecutive grades of 'F' in 2022-23 (baseline year could only use to exit school improvement status), and 2021-22 school years. Madison requested closure of Greenville Elementary School and reassignment of the students to Madison County Central School.

Superintendent Dr. Karen Pickles will present evidence of the conditions set by the State Board in January that are currently being implemented by Madison County School District.
