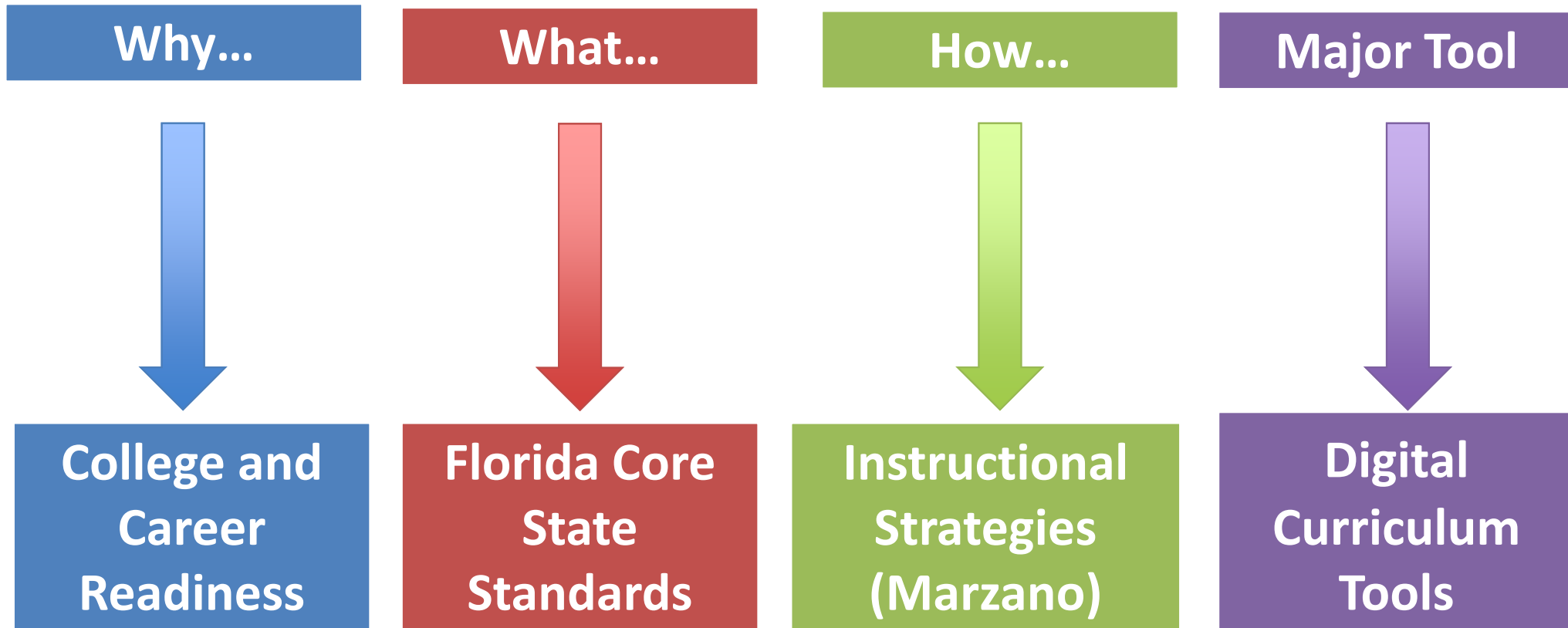

- Level 3 offenses decreased by 56 percentage points
- Level 4 offenses decreased by 50 percentage points
- Mobility rates are down by 10 percentage points
- Attendance rates are up by 1 percentage point
