SUBJECT: 2020-21 CAPE Postsecondary Industry Certification Funding List Recommendation Submission Window

The Division of Career and Adult Education and the Division of Florida Colleges announce the opening of the 2020-21 CAPE (Career and Professional Education) Postsecondary Industry Certification Funding List submission window for recommended industry certifications.

Last year, our state's district postsecondary institutions and Florida College institutions received \$20.5 million in combined incentive funding as a result of the CAPE Act. We are excited to invite additional submissions — especially in view of helping to alleviate any economic impact the COVID-19 emergency may have. As you may know, the CAPE Act was created to provide a statewide planning partnership between business and education in view of expanding and retaining high-value industry and maintaining a vibrant economy. The CAPE Act's incentive funding, together with your renewed commitment to graduating a skilled workforce, positions the state and its residents remarkably well during this time and moving forward.

Certifications must tie to an occupational area included in the General Appropriations Act for performance-based incentive funds. The General Appropriations Act has recently added a new occupational area: Unmanned Aircraft Systems, for Florida College System institutions. The occupational areas eligible for performance-based incentive funding are listed in the tables below:
