The Florida Student Success Center is excited to partner with the Community College Research Center and The Aspen Institute to provide a webinar opportunity to present [The Dual Enrollment Playbook: A Guide to Equitable Acceleration for Students](#) to the Florida College System on **November 19, 2020, from 9:00-10:45 a.m.** The playbook is the culmination of a multi-year project analyzing data on access to and success in dual enrollment programs and visiting high school and community college partnerships in Florida as well as Ohio and Washington with strong results for advancing equity through dual enrollment. The resulting findings will provide guidance to school, district, and college leaders and practitioners across the country on how to strengthen dual enrollment programs to serve students historically underrepresented in higher education.

During the webinar, representatives from CCRC and Aspen will present their findings as well as tools they have developed for getting started and assessing equitable dual enrollment practices. Participants will also hear from practitioners engaged in this work and participate in a breakout session focused on peer sharing and learning.
