SUBJECT: Approval of New Rule 6A-14.0306, Florida Administrative Code,

Death Benefits for Survivors of First Responders and Military Members

On July 15, 2020, the State Board of Education approved Rule 6A-14.0306, Florida Administrative Code, Death Benefits for Survivors of First Responders and Military Members. The rule provides Florida College System (FCS) institutions with additional guidance to ascertain student eligibility for the tuition waiver. A copy of the rule is attached for your reference.

In 2019, Senate Bill 7098 (Chapter No. 2019-24, Laws of Florida) created sections 112.1912 and 295.061, Florida Statutes, which require the state to waive the cost of tuition and certain fees that the child or spouse of a deceased first responder (including Florida National Guard) or deceased active duty service member of the United States Armed Forces (U.S Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, and Coast Guard) incurs at a career center, FCS institution or state university.
