## SUBJECT: 2020-2021 Perkins V Basic Grant Roll Forward Funds

Federal statutes require that roll forward funds from 2019-2020 be allocated to enhance the original funds received during the 2020-2021 fiscal year, using the same formulas approved by the U.S. Department of Education for secondary and postsecondary career and technical education programs.

In the attachments you will find the allocation of funds for school districts, career and technical centers, and colleges. These roll forward allocation charts are also available on the web at: <a href="http://www.fldoe.org/academics/career-adult-edu/funding-opportunities">http://www.fldoe.org/academics/career-adult-edu/funding-opportunities</a>. The amounts represent additional dollars your agency may acquire through the project amendment process. The funding period for roll forward funds will be from the date we receive your amendment, in acceptable form, through June 30, 2021.

To acquire the additional funds reflected in the allocation charts, you must upload DOE 150 and 151 Budget Amendment Forms to the Office of Grants Management via Sharefile System. These funds are to be treated as basic grant funds and used to enhance a current project, as well as support program of sufficient size, scope and quality, provided they are reflected in your agency's approved plan.
