The following list contains a sampling of activities from across the district at various elementary, middle, and high schools.

Monday, January 25	<ul> <li>Beta Club literacy fact posters will be displayed around the school.</li> <li>Parent Read Aloud- Parents will record themselves reading and share it with the teacher to play for the students in class.</li> <li>Teachers will post a picture of themselves reading a favorite book.</li> </ul>
Tuesday, January 26	<ul> <li>Students will write a letter of appreciation to a student, teacher, or staff member.</li> <li>Students will receive a prize when they are caught reading around school.</li> <li>Famous Quote/Biography Dress-Up Day- Students will dress in the attire of a person who has positively influenced our world. They will include the quote or book title with their outfit.</li> </ul>
Wednesday, January 27	<ul> <li>Dictionary Day- Students will choose a word from the dictionary (with the theme of "Humanity Tells a Story") and dress up as that word. The students will have the word and definition attached to their outfit.</li> <li>Students will receive a candy prize as they check out books.</li> <li>Teachers will post videos of themselves reading a book on social media so that students can view the read aloud at home.</li> </ul>
Thursday, January 28	<ul> <li>Virtual Literacy Night- PTA and the public library will host an evening of online literacy activities.</li> <li>Book Character Dress-Up Day</li> <li>Flip Grid Book Chat on the Morning Announcements</li> </ul>
Friday, January 29	<ul> <li>Teachers will read a story relating to the year's theme with their classes.</li> <li>Surprise Drop Everything and Read Time for the School</li> <li>Students across the school will create an interactive display of their favorite books.</li> </ul>
