The following list contains a sampling of activities from across the district at various elementary, middle, and high schools.

Monday, January 25	 Beta Club literacy fact posters will be displayed around the school. Parent Read Aloud- Parents will record themselves reading and share it with the teacher to play for the students in class. Teachers will post a picture of themselves reading a favorite book.
Tuesday, January 26	 Students will write a letter of appreciation to a student, teacher, or staff member. Students will receive a prize when they are caught reading around school. Famous Quote/Biography Dress-Up Day- Students will dress in the attire of a person who has positively influenced our world. They will include the quote or book title with their outfit.
Wednesday, January 27	 Dictionary Day- Students will choose a word from the dictionary (with the theme of "Humanity Tells a Story") and dress up as that word. The students will have the word and definition attached to their outfit. Students will receive a candy prize as they check out books. Teachers will post videos of themselves reading a book on social media so that students can view the read aloud at home.
Thursday, January 28	 Virtual Literacy Night- PTA and the public library will host an evening of online literacy activities. Book Character Dress-Up Day Flip Grid Book Chat on the Morning Announcements
Friday, January 29	 Teachers will read a story relating to the year's theme with their classes. Surprise Drop Everything and Read Time for the School Students across the school will create an interactive display of their favorite books.
